Sub: Inviting applications for Short term goal oriented projects of LDC-IL - reg.

Linguistic Data Consortium for Indian Languages (LDC-IL) Project was established by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India during XI<sup>th</sup> Plan period in the Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore. It has a mission to provide "Annotated, quality language data (both-text & speech) and tools in Indian Languages to Individuals, Institutions and Industry for Research & Development - Created in house, through outsourcing and acquisition".

LDC-IL is organizing a short term goal oriented projects for various Indian languages from **Oct. 2012 to Feb. 2013** to achieve the set targets of LDC-IL. The duration of this short term project will be 30-45 days depending upon the workload of the concerned language.

For the said purpose, applications are invited from the eligible candidates with PG in Linguistics/literature and knowledge in computer handling. Selected candidates are expected to work on corpus cleaning and speech data annotation. They will be paid daily **honorarium of Rs.750/-for each working day** and 3<sup>rd</sup> AC train fare for to and fro journey subject to the production of the ticket. Accommodation will be arranged within the campus at nominal rates.
